Tom Rauner is the Primary Care Office Director for DHHS's Office of Rural Health. He works with a number of programs involving the preparation and placement of health care providers in underserved areas including the National Health Service Corps (NHSC), the National Rural Recruitment and Retention Network and the Nebraska Office of Rural Health Incentive Programs. He was involved with creating the Health Professions Tracking System in Nebraska which continuously monitors the practice location of physicians, nurse practitioners, physician assistants, behavioral health providers and dentists. He also leads the NHSC Multi-State Retention Collaborative effort.

We must retain employees in order to build a strong behavioral health workforce in Nebraska. Yet many employers struggle to keep good people employed.

This webinar will focus on the unique challenges of retaining the psychiatric prescriber workforce — psychiatrists, psychiatric nurse practitioners, and psychiatric physician assistants.
